



FTIC Dual / Transfer Credit

The Office of Institutional Effectiveness is back with a refresh on last year’s data bite featuring a common question of:

“How much Dual Credit does a new student come with?”

This year we added 5 more years of historical data as well as data from the past year 2022. We also added in the average amount of credit a student comes with (a post-data bite question we received from a faculty member).

From the chart below, you can see that there is a slight decrease in the number of First-Time, Full-Time students enrolling at WT with credit hours (a decline of 2.5 percentage points over the past 10 years). There has also been a slight increase in the average number of hours students are bringing in between 11.4 (min) and 13.9 (max) average credit hours. Over the past 10 years your students have come in somewhere in this range.

While the data does show slight increases and decreases in the past 10-years, none of the changes are drastic enough to affect needed course availability by incoming First-Time, Full-Time Freshman.
