

Timely Warning Notification: Aggravated Assault

The Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act (Clery Act) is a federal law that requires colleges and universities across the United States to disclose information about crime on and around their campuses. A requirement of this law is timely notification to the campus community of certain crimes in a manner that will aid in the prevention of similar crimes.

AGGRAVATED ASSAULT

On January 8, 2023, the University Police Department was made aware of a reported incident that occurred just before midnight on Jan. 6, 2023. The incident was reported to have occurred in a University recognized private residence, immediately adjacent to campus.

The incident is actively being investigated by law enforcement. Following the completion of the incident report, the case will be presented to the Randall County District Attorney's Office.

Crime victim rights and options were provided. Title IX is aware of the reported incidents.

WTAMU and the University Police strongly encourage everyone to use good judgement and be an active player in your own safety. Review the following prevention strategies related to fighting and arguments:

- Verbal provocation alone is not justification to assault a person
- Do not provoke others with words or actions
